Courses

EXED 5750V. Internship in Extension. 1-6 Hour.

A supervised practical work experience in Cooperative Extension which is designed to give the student an insight into the role of Extension employees and an opportunity to gain professional competence in this area. (Typically offered: Fall, Spring and Summer) May be repeated for up to 6 hours of degree credit. This course is cross-listed with ACOM 5750V, AGLE 5750V, ASTM 5750V.

EXED 58203. Program Planning in Agricultural and Extension Education. 3 Hours.

Consideration of the need for planning programs in education; objectives and evaluation of community programs; use of advisory group; organization and use of facilities. Prerequisite: Graduate standing. (Typically offered: Irregular)
