Interdisciplinary Studies B.A. Eight-Semester Degree Plan

Students wishing to follow the eight-semester degree plan should see the Academic Regulations chapter for university requirements. Once all state minimum core requirements are met, students may substitute a 3-hour (or more) general elective in place of a core area.
